The Food Bank for Westchester will benefit from a newly-formed partnership with Westchester Foodies, a service-based company that provides culinary and entertainment promotions to its customers via weekly cell phone text messages.

For each new customer it signs up, Westchester Foodies will donate \$1 to Food Bank for Westchester. For every dollar received, the Food Bank is able to acquire \$4 worth of food to provide to hungry people in the county.

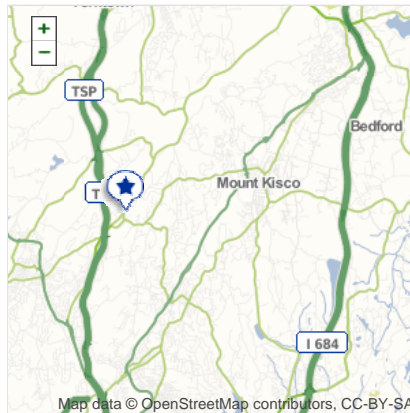
