You may be eligible for government assistance via SNAP (food stamps) even if you work, own a home, have a car, have a bank account and are not a citizen but have children who are citizens. Anyone interested in learning about SNAP benefits and getting help completing and submitting an application for food assistance can take advantage of a program offered by the Food Bank for Westchester. SNAP Coordinator Marilyn Rivera, who is bilingual in English and Spanish, can help you determine if you are eligible for SNAP (food stamp) benefits and also help you complete and submit your

application.
