You may be eligible for government assistance via SNAP (food stamps) even if you work, own a home, have a car, have a bank account and are not a citizen but have children who are citizens. Anyone interested in learning about SNAP benefits and getting help completing and submitting an application for food assistance can take advantage of a program offered by the **Food Bank for Westchester**.
