A 2007 childhood obesity study by the Westchester County Department of Health revealed that 34 percent of kindergarten, second grade and fourth grade children in surveyed Westchester schools are overweight or at risk of becoming overweight. This compares with a national average of 32.2 percent and a New York State average of around 25 percent. This alarming epidemic is jeopardizing the future health of our citizens.
