Food Bank names Cox nutrition resource manager

The Food Bank for Westchester is pleased to announce that Sara Cox has been appointed nutrition resource manager. In this role, Ms. Cox will provide nutrition and food safety information and training to staff and clients of the Food Bank and its 200 frontline hunger-relief member programs, including food pantries and soup kitchens. She will also serve as the food safety compliance officer for Food Bank member programs and product quality control. She will be working very closely with the New York State Department of Health Hunger Prevention and Nutrition Assistance Program on food quality and food safety issues.

Ms. Cox holds a degree in science and nutrition from Montclair State University in New Jersey. She also recently attained a culinary arts degree from the Institute of Culinary Education.

The Food Bank for Westchester is located at 358 Saw Mill River Road, Millwood.

One of eight food banks in New York State, the Food Bank acquires, warehouses and distributes more than
