## **ORGANIZATION CELEBRATES 90 YEARS OF GIVING**

The Westchester County Federation of Women's Clubs celebrated its 90 years of service during an event held earlier this spring at The Davenport Club in New

Rochelle. The event was designed to recognize the organization's service to promote the welfare of Westchester County in civic, legislative, educational, philanthropic, moral and cultural matters. There are currently some 3,000 federation members in 25 clubs in the county. In addition to promoting the work of the federation, the members volunteer time and funding to help their local communities through programs devoted to seniors, children and scholarships. Since 1963, the organization has honored an outstanding woman for her contributions to the world at large through her local efforts. Christina Rohatynskij, executive director of The Food Bank for Westchester (formerly Food-PATCH, People Allied to Combat Hunger), was honored as the 2011 Woman of the Year.
