Here's a few ideas for using those items with a long shelf lives:

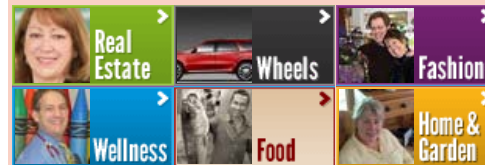

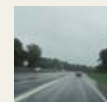

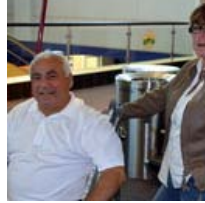
