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The Food Bank for Westchester, one of Westchester's largest emergency food distribution organizations, has signed a long-term lease for 36,688 square feet of [industrial space](#) at 200 Clearbrook Rd. in Elmsford, NY.

The 94,000 square-foot manufacturing building sits on 4.6 acres in the West I-287 Corridor submarket of

Westchester County.

The new tenant will be relocating its headquarters from its current location at 358 Saw Mill River Rd. in Millwood. The recent bad economy has affected many Westchester families who are struggling to make ends meet, thus increasing the need for food. The Food Bank had outgrown its current location and had been searching for a new location that would fit their needs.
